Patience and Trust

Above all, trust in the slow work of Love - in the very slow work of healing and wholeness. Trust the slow movement of your journey from disorientation to clarity, from darkness to light.

We are quite naturally impatient in everything to reach the end without delay.
We should like to skip the intermediate stages.
We are impatient of being on the way to something unknown, something new.
And yet it is the law of all progress that it is made by passing through some stages of instability—and that it may take a very long time.

And so I think it is with you; your ideas mature gradually—let them grow, let them shape themselves, without undue haste. Don't try to force them on, as though you could be today what time (that is to say, grace and circumstances acting on your own good will) will make of you tomorrow.

Only time, insight, hope, and faith could say what this new growth gradually forming within you will be. Even if you are still in the dark, believe in your becoming. Believe in your step towards this faint light, this hand leading you, and accept the anxiety of feeling yourself in suspense and incomplete.
